CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS GRANTED

1. If a scholarship recipient accepts more than \$7,500 per year or \$30,000 for 4 years from additional scholarships, federal or state grants, the Crawford-Zbanek Scholarship will not be awarded and will be given to the first runner-up.
2. The recipient must attend four consecutive years at a 4-year Texas college or university. A year constitutes fall and spring semesters. Scholarship funds are not awarded for study outside the state of Texas.
3. The recipient must achieve a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 in the Freshman year. For every semester thereafter, she must achieve a 3.0 cumulative or better.
4. The recipient must be a full-time female student, carrying a minimum of 12 credit hours.
5. The \$1500 yearly scholarship will be given the recipient upon verification of her acceptance at a four-year Texas college or university.

The awarded funds will be paid as follows:

- one-half the principal sum upon receipt of fall semester fee statement;
- The balance will be sent upon receipt of fall grades (official transcript) and a copy of spring fee statement.
